- At the time of writing, the arrangements for Wimbledon are unknown, due to the ongoing Coronavirus restrictions.

### FLOODLIGHTS

- **Andy Mayo, Head Coach (tel. 07920 498021) supplies Floodlight Cards**, as does **Paul Heald-Barraclough (tel. 07752 870586, email paulhbarracough@talktalk.net)**
- Each card costs £2 and lasts for 35 minutes. A warning light activates 5 minutes before a card runs out. If playing for more than 35 minutes, insert all cards one after the other. Should you not do that and the lights go out, it will take 10 minutes before they come on again, since the lamps have to cool first, prior to further illumination.

### VISITORS

- At the time of writing, Coronavirus restrictions mean that Visitors are unable to play at the club. The Visitors policy will evolve as restrictions are lifted through the year and updates will be available on the website.

### COACHING

### COURTS

- **FOOTWEAR** – Wear only tennis shoes on court – no shoes with studs or ribbed soles.
- Use Courts 2 and 3 if they are free. This will prevent excessive wear of Court 1.
- During the leaf-fall season, members must “drag” the court to clear it of leaves and autumn debris.
- If you are the last player(s) on court, you must ensure that the courts are locked.
- Courts may be booked 6 days in advance, using the booking sheet displayed on the Club noticeboard.
